One of the newest distillery's in Scotland, the Island of Arran is off the West Coast of the Lowlands and sheltered by the Kintyre peninsula. Creamy and leafy with a nose of fresh peat smoke.

Full in colour and sherryish with a spirity finish.

No Age Speyside

Aultmore

Malty, herbal and oaky.

12 Speyside

Auchroisk

A pure single malt with exceptionally mellow overtones. Aged in sherry casks from Spain, gives a smooth balanced taste with a deep rich fruit finish.

Balvenie Founders Reserve

An orange and honey nose with a taste of sherry. Very lively on the palate and a lingering honey finish

Balvenie Double Wood

First and second Bourbon casks, then 6 to 12 months in sweet Oloroso casks gives a combined taste of mellow flavours

Benromach

A classic Speyside malt from the smallest working distillery in the area. Owned and managed by Gordon & MacPhail it is Golden, amber in colour, the nose has sweet notes with a cinnamon and clove spiciness, there is also a subtle hint of fruit - apples. On the palate the fruitiness continues with a touch of sherry wood and a smoky edge.

No Age Speyside

Benromach Organic

The Worlds first Organic malt Whisky as certified by the Soil Association. Dark Gold in colour, a Speysider with an unique flavour, sweetness on the palate with a hint of smoke. Verging on a Bourbon style finish

No Age Speyside

Balmenach Connoisseurs Choice

Situated in the "Haughs of Cromdale", Balmenach was one of the first licensed distilleries.

1988 Speyside

Benriach Peated

The distillery was founded in 1898 and is situated next door to its sister distillery. Longmorn.

A nicely balanced, fruity whisky with nutty, spicy and malty aromas.

Benrinnes

The dominant peak among the mountains overlooking Speyside, Benrinnes gives it's name to the distillery founed as

early as 1820 and rebuilt in the 1950's. A reddish brown colour with a heavy almost creamy nose. Slightly smoky

Blair Athol

12 Highland

Located near Pitlochry this picturesque distillery dates back to 1798. A fresh clean nose and light body with a smooth finish.

Bruichladdich 2nd

12 Islay

Pale gold in colour with soft subtle hints of exotic spices combined with a light peaty aroma.

Light in body with delicate flavours which give way to a lingering sweetness.

Bruichladdich Chateau

15 Islay

Matured in Chateau d`Yquem barrels for 25 weeks. Before 15 years in Bourbon Casks.

Mellow, rich nutty, exotic, honeyed, fresh fruit salad.

Bunnahabhain

12 Islay

Glowing amber with a light delicate nose. Light to medium bodied with a fruity, full and refreshing finish.

Cardhu

12 Speyside

Cardhu is the soft heart of the Johnnie Walker blends. Pale in colour with a light smooth body

It has a lingering sweetness and a hint of peat.

Caol Ila

12 Islay

The name - pronounced 'cull-eela' - is gaelic for 'Sound of Islay'. The distillery is appropriately hidden in a cove near Port Askaig. A well-balanced, full flavoured dram with medicinal, floral, spicy, nutty and smoky notes all present.

Cragganmore

12 Speyside

Complex, mature and well balanced with a slight fruitiness on the tongue, overlaid with sweet smoky notes.

Clynelish Connoisseurs Choice

1991 Highland

A coastal malt which has slightly Island character. Starts malty and becomes sweetish when water is added. Visibly oily.

Convalmore Connoisseurs Choice

1981 Speyside

Bright lemony colour with a fruit, syrupy nose.

Cudhu Black

A black whisky, produced to replace the infamous but much loved Loch Dhu and now developing a bit of a following.

Cu Dhub means Black Dog in Gaelic.

Dallas Dhu

1982 Speyside

Dailuaine

16 Speyside

Matured in Refill American Hogsheads. You don't see many bottlings from Dailuaine around any more!

Dalwhinnie

Smooth, yellow, subtle with a heathery honey taste and just a hint of smoke. Dalwhinnie is the Gaelic for 'meeting place' and is the highest distillery in Scotland.

Dufftown

Pale golden, syrupy on the palate and well rounded

15 Highland

Edradour

Tastes of honey and dried fruits but has a mint like spiciness. Full bodied and fruity with a buttery, cream finish.

10 Highland

Glenlossie

Once used in the Haig blends, this malt has a nutty sherry finish with a hint of peat.

Glenmorangie

Fragrant, delicate, sophisticated and clean. Well balanced with a subtle smokiness giving a fresh aromatic and refined taste.

Glendullan

Glendullan was the last of the original seven distilleries of Dufftown when it was built in 1897-98.

Glen Ord

Sweet and malt on the nose, with a dry gingery, spicy, smooth finish.

Glenrothes Select Reserve

Only a small percentage of this malt is bottled for sale, the rest going to blenders. A classic Speysider, a must try.

No Age Speyside

Glen Spey

An aperitif style whisky, which is generally light, grassy and drying

Glen Elgin

This whisky replaced the popular Flora & Fauna bottling and is a tasty, malty Speyside

Glen Devron

10 year old Highland Malt from Macduff Distillery. Light with a hint of smoke.

Glenmorangie Port Wood

Soothing and relaxing finish with a pronounced fruit and winey nose

Glentauchers

Spiced initially with the sherry slowly developing. A subtle smoky note.

Glenturret

A medium-bodied whisky with subtle smokiness.

Pale golden in colour with a light body and A very salty finish		
Isle of Jura	10	Island
Close to Isaly, Jura is the Norse word for deer. bright golden colour with a oily nose and a little maltiness in the finish An elegant malt with a very delicate finish and a light creamy body		
Knockando	12	Speyside
An elegant malt with a very delicate finish and a light creamy body		
Lagavulin	16	Islay
Intense, potent and pungent with rich peatiness and deep smoke and a sweet finish in the mouth.		
Laphroaig	10	Islay
Full golden in colour with a phenolic, seaweedy , peaty nose. Rich and smoky, fully peated with a hint of sweetness. Salty.		
Linkwood	15	Speyside
A remarkably flowery malt with a medium rounded body and a dryish smooth finish		
Macallan Fine Oak	10	Speyside
The richness is enhanced by the use of especially small stills in the distilling process and the use of sherry casks to age. A full amber colour with a fruity nose and grassy and slightly peaty finish		
Macallan	10	Speyside
Deep amber in colour, with a slight sweet nose. Least peaty of all malts with a slight sherry nose. Very smooth with hints of sherry and wood. Well rounded and slightly sweet.		
Macallan	18	Speyside
The richness is enhanced by the use of especially small stills in the distilling process and the use of sherry casks to age. A full amber colour with a fruity nose and grassy and slightly peaty finish		
Mannochmore	12	Speyside
Robust malt with a peppery and fruity taste yet a fragrant and flowery nose		
Miltonduff	10	Speyside
Fragrant and flowery with a hint of peat. Firm and soothing finish		
Mortlach	16	Speyside
Rich and amber in colour with a long dry finish. Medium to full body yet smooth.		

North Port Brechin Connoisseurs Choice	1981	Highland
A fruity but very dry whisky, which whisky writer Michael Jackson described as 'gin-like'.		
Oban	14	Highland
Rich, elegant and glowing with sea air notes and an underlying rich fruitiness.		
Old Pulteney	12	Highland
Deep yellow in colour with a dry yet peaty nose delivering a soothing,oily and salty finish.		
Pittyvaich	12	Speyside
Built in 1975 but mothballed in 1993, this malt is deep amber in colour with spicy ,perfumy and very dry finish		
Royal Brackla	10	Highland
Royal Brackla was the first distillery to be given a royal warrant in 1835, sweet otes slightly malty		
Royal Brackla Connoisseurs Choice	1991	Highland
Bottled in 2006 and matured in refill sherry casks. One for sherry cask fans		
Royal Lochnagar	12	Highland
The distillery lies on the banks of the river Dee. One and a half miles from Balmoral, the whisky received the royal seal from Queen Victoria. Lightly smoky with a sweet malt taste, it has a sherry nose and a smoky finish.		
Rosebank	12	Lowland
Distilling started around the 1790's and the distillery was closed in 1993 to much protest. Golden in colour with a crisp sharp finish		
Springbank	10	Campbletown
Extremely aromatic on the nose, good depth of palate. Malty and sweet with a long elegant finish.		
Strathmill	12	Speyside
Built from a corn mill in 1891 and located in the town of Keith, this malt is dryish with a hint of cloves.		
Talisker	10	Islands
Powerful, sweet and robust. Maritime on the nose - sweet, spicy undertones on the tongue.		
Tamdhu	No Age	Speyside
Founded in 1896 and rebuilt in the 1970's this is a versatile malt with a hint of peat and a clear sweet taste.		
Tomatin	12	Highland
Complex bouquet with a rich malty and fruity aroma. A wonderfully rich and elegant taste producing a long and satisfying finish.		
Tormore	12	Speyside
Admirers consider this to be a aromatic,sweet and easily drinkable malt		

Tamnavulin

Natural gold in colour. Well matured with a light, sweet, slightly floral bouquet. A bright invigorating slightly smoky flavour.

Founded in 1817 this malt contributes to various blends including VAT 69 and Dimple. Big fresh nose with a leafy finish
